Health and Safety Risk Awareness - Level 2

Course Aim / General Introduction:

If a risk management strategy is to be truly successful, organisations must embed a risk management philosophy throughout the organisation. As risks start to be devolved and managed at departmental and divisional levels it is imperative that all those involved in the process are fully trained on what is expected of them. This course is generally aimed at most personnel to help them understand the process and embed effective risk management philosophies throughout their operations.
